# PRESS RELEASE

**Hinds County Resident –Anthony L. Robinson Plead Guilty to Convicted Felon in Possession of a Firearm ordered to serve 10 years in the Custody of MDOC to run concurrent with the Rankin County Charges.**

(Jackson, Miss) Hinds County District Attorney Robert Shuler Smith announced on November 3, 2016, that Hinds County resident, Anthony L. Robinson plead guilty to Convicted Felon in Possession of a Firearm. Hinds County Judge William Gowan ordered Anthony L. Robinson to serve 10 years to run current with Rankin County charges in the custody of the Mississippi Department of Correction.

On February 11, 2016, while on patrol, JPD Detectives received information of possible drug trafficking on Macon Street. Upon arrival, JPD Detectives observed a vehicle occupied with two subjects parked at an abandoned house on Macon Street. After a field interview was conducted, the driver of the vehicle was identified as Anthony L. Robinson.

According to the Detectives, an NCIC check revealed an active MDOC warrant for Anthony L. Robinson. After Robinson was taken into custody, Detectives noticed a silver and black object which appeared to be a handgun under the driver seat. The handgun was loaded with three live rounds of ammunition in the magazine. The weapon was secured and removed from the vehicle. Anthony Robinson admitted to JPD Detectives that the gun was his.
